Exam Findings:

Numerous deep puncture wounds on skin of front flippers.



These wounds were severely infected.

These wounds are healing



TREATMENT FOR: CARTER

Debridement to remove dead tissue from wound.

Chlorhexidine solution and saline used to flush out debris in wound.

Meloxicam & Tramadol: Pain Medication

Sulfadiazine cream on wounds: Antibacterial and antifungal

Fluids and tube feeding (no longer necessary. Now eats very well.)
