Exam Findings:

Lethargic
Emaciated
Epibiota and debris on carapace including sand and algae.
Small barnacles on skin.

Diagnostic workup findings:

Mild anemia, low glucose, low blood protein (indicating muscle trauma), low calcium/high phosphorus and dehydration.



TREATMENT FOR:
Condron

(MAY BE PREVIOUS OR CURRENT)

IV fluids for dehydration

Tube fed for nutrition.

Metrionidazole (antibiotic for anaerobic bacterial infections)

Ceftazidime (injectable antibiotic)

Iron supplement for anemia.

PRESCRIBED: DR. NORTON, DVM

Condron was found with a Passive Integrated Transmitter (PIT tag) already in place indicating that it was rehabilitated previously at the Karen Beasley Sea Turtle Rescue Center in North Carolina and released in 2011.
