FOR:

IV fluids for dehydration, tube
fed a nutrient rich gruel until
eating

Ceftazidime (antibiotic for
aerobic bacterial infections)

Iron supplement for anemia

Vitamin K to help with blood
clotting

PRESCRIBED: *DR. NORTON, DVM*

Exam Findings:

Lethargic and emaciated

Several large barnacles including one on
head and another partially covering eye.

Thick green algae at
posterior end of carapace.
Excessive bleeding, possible
blood clotting abnormality

Diagnostic Workup Findings:

Anemia, low blood protein,
elevated blood phosphorus
