Diagnostic Results:

Blood Work: Low Glucose and Anemic

X-Rays: Missing part of right front flipper



TREATMENT FOR: FOX

IV fluids and glucose

Ceftazidime: Antibiotic for aerobic bacteria

Metronidazole: Antibiotic for anaerobic bacteria

Honey: Tube fed initially to increase blood glucose

Calcium Gluconate

Vitamin K
