Diagnostic Results:

Blood work: Normal
X-rays: Suspicion of pneumonia
CT scan: Evidence of bullae on the left lung
Vertebral fracture suggests blunt force trauma



**TREATMENT
FOR: Grayton**

Pyrantel pamoate: Dewormer

Cisapride: Gut motility

Iron: Anemia

Weight therapy: Floating

Aspiration: Air-removal (unsuccessful)
