IV fluids until rehydrated
and eating

Calcium Gluconate

Ceftazidime: Antibiotic for treatment of
aerobic bacterial infections

Metronidazole: Antibiotic for treatment
of anaerobic bacteria

Ferrous Sulfate: iron supplement for
anemia

Shana natural remedy for FP given
orally

Isolation from other turtle without FP

PRESCRIBED: *DR. NORTON, DVM*
(MAY BE PREVIOUS OR CURRENT)

Exam Findings:

Heavy load of epibiota on carapace including Sea
Squirts, Bryozoans, and Barnacles

Fracture in Hind Flipper

Diagnostic Results:

Blood Work: Low Glucose, Anemic

X-rays: Fracture in Hind Flipper

Biopsy of Small Lesion: Positive for FP
