for anemia

Exam Findings:

Heavy load of epibiota on carapace
including sea squirts, barnacles, and
bryozoans

Leeches and eggs on plastron

Missing left rear flipper

Diagnostic:

Blood Work: low glucose

X-rays: Missing Left Rear Flipper
