**Exam Findings:**

Floating

Multiple small raised FP lesions in inguinal area, right eye, and base of front flippers

Small flat suspicious lesions in auxiliary regions

**Diagnostic workup findings:**

Very low glucose, low/moderate calcium

**Radiographs (x-ray):** Presence of gas



**INITIAL TREATMENT FOR:**

Shelly

IV fluids until rehydrated and eating:  
LRS + 5% dextrose, LRS +2.5% dextrose  
Tube fed honey on day of arrival  
Metronidazole: Antibiotic for treatment of anaerobic bacteria (given orally)  
Amikacin: Antibiotic for treatment of bacterial infections (injection)  
Cisapride: gut motility drug (given orally)  
Shana: a nutraceutical effective against herpesvirus and fungal infections. We are testing this on some of the milder cases of FP that are presented to us. The drug is given both orally and topically.
